

Please read the guidelines below for full details of who may apply and how the applications will be assessed.

1. The Paul Pfeuti Young Musician Trust is keen to offer financial contributions to individual young musicians. Most awards will be between £25 and £100. The Trust does not support groups or organisations.
2. Application closing dates are: 1st January; 1st May and 1st September annually.
3. The Trust is keen to support primary and secondary school age musicians in full-time education. This includes students in Sixth Forms and FE colleges.
4. Applicants must be resident in North Lancashire, North Yorkshire, Isle of Man or South Lakes. If the applicant is not British they must have lived in the UK for at least three years at the appropriate closing date.
5. The Trust will consider contributing to a wide variety of musical pursuits. These could include for example a one-off masterclass, examination fees, travel to an audition, the purchase of a new musical instrument, a contribution to the fees of a residential music course or an international music tour.
6. The Trust will not contribute to the cost of regular instrumental/vocal lessons with the same teacher.
7. The assessing panel will normally meet within a month of the closing date and contact applicants shortly after this time. The decision of the assessing panel is final. The assessing panel may need to contact the applicant before making a final decision about an application to confirm or request more information.
8. If the application is successful the Trust would appreciate receiving a written report of the project outcomes and may invite you to perform at a Trust concert in the future.
9. If the application is successful and your project plans change, you must get in touch with us immediately. The Trust reserves the right to reclaim or alter the award if it sees fit.
